Help Paying for Childcare Costs

We may be able to help. Childcare subsidy assistance is available to eligible families that meet the state's low-income guidelines and need help paying for childcare costs in order to work or engage in other work related activities; for a teen parent to attend high school; for families where a parent or adult caretaker is unable to provide care due to a physical or mental incapacity; or where family duties of a parent or caretaker relative take them away from home. Families are guaranteed childcare assistance if they are on public assistance and need childcare in order to meet work participation requirements. Childcare assistance is also guaranteed for one year after leaving public assistance if the public assistance case closed due to earnings or increased child support. Availability of subsidy for low income applicants is also contingent upon state/federal funding.

Eligibility:

Eligibility is based on family size and family income. The maximum monthly income for household size must be at or below the levels in the chart at the left. You must be a resident of Oswego County.

Who is eligible?

Families with children age 12 or younger who:

- ⇒ Meet income guidelines (See chart at left);
- ⇒ Are temporary assistance clients who are working or enrolled in approved employment programs.
